Leaders serving in leadership roles during the 2018/19 school year, and are not either a current principal or superintendent, can obtain Leadership Certification through an in-service program connecting their current practices and experiences with the competencies in the Leadership Quality Standard. This includes CASS members serving in system level leadership roles. As requested by the membership, the **Leadership Quality Standard Certification In-Service “B”** will be offered at the CASS conference and will focus on the role of the system leader.

As a result of attending you will have the opportunity to:

- Enhance your leadership capacity based on the LQS certification In-service outcomes – and based on your role as a system leader.
- Receive “Leadership Certification” from the Ministry for completion of the two-day In-service.

CASS members currently in system level leadership roles have the opportunity to obtain certification for both the LQS and SLQS by attending the two-day in-service certification programs prior to December 2019. Attendance at the LQS certification in-service program must occur before the SLQS certification in-service program.
